Outcom

To understand what perserverance means. To know that even when something is really difficult we should keep trying and not give up.

Compassion - What feelings will we evoke?

Empathy for how the characters in the story feel.

Empathy for the bear.

How to overcome not wanting to do something because it is hard.

Building our resiliance.

Community - Who or what can support us?

Look at the jobs people do in our local environment and what would happen if they decided it was too hard and gave up, such as street cleaning, bin men, lollippp man etc

Considering adult job roles in school - What if the cleaners and the lunchtime staff gave up?

Show that our actions can impact not only us but our wider community too.
